

Hawaii Area Representative

Tommy Lum has served as the Hawaii Area Representative to District 20 since the position was created in 2001. He is resigning at the end of December, and the Unit Board of Directors, in coordination with other units in Hawaii, will select a new Area Representative for a three year term. The purpose of this notice is to provide an opportunity for any unit member interested in this position to notify the Board President, John Spangler, of your interest.

The duties of the position include (1) serving as a point of contact for problems or issues that arise between the district organization and the Hawaii area; (2) attending three district meetings each year held in conjunction with regional tournaments; (3) presenting Hawaii area issues at those meetings in coordination with the Hawaii area Boards of Directors and reporting back to the Boards following each meeting..

Note that the unit does not support travel by the area representative to the district meetings financially. The representative must be willing to travel at his/her own expense. For this reason attendance at each and every meeting is not a requirement.
